Job Descriptions

Dining Hall Cleaning Supervisor: Oversee dish crew and dining area clean up crew, to insure a clean and inviting environment is maintained. Must have positive attitude, an eye for maintaining an attractive atmosphere, and work well with people.

Dish Crew: Work in Dish room cleaning dishes following meals.

Dining Hall Cleanup crew: Assist in cleaning tables and floors following each meal.

Maintenance Persons: Assist in upgrade and emergency repairs to the Camp facility.

Restroom Cleaning Supervisor: Oversee bathroom crew, (male and female crew members for cleaning of Men's and Ladies rooms respectively) in using wise judgment in care of the camp restroom facilities in a well serviced and clean manner. Inspect the bathrooms regularly, to assure that our bathrooms are constantly clean. Must be meticulous and work well with people.

Restroom Cleaning Crew: Maintain restroom supplies and cleanliness through out the day.

Security Officer: Secure safety of camp overnight. Prefer some experience in security related field, and would prefer Red Cross First Responder certification, as well as CPR.
