Camp Code of Conduct

1. All individuals & vehicles staying on the grounds overnight must be registered at the camp office upon arrival.
2. It is required that we dress in an appropriate & modest manner for the occasion (i.e. church, recreation, etc.). Men are to wear shirts at all times except when engaged in active sports. Halters are not acceptable women's wear. No short shorts.
3. No profanity, smoking, possession or use of illegal drugs, or drinking alcoholic beverages is permitted on the grounds.
4. Fireworks, explosives, firearms or any dangerous weapons are not permitted at any time, except for approved, programmed demonstrations.
5. If there are any pets on the grounds, they must be registered at the Camp Office. Proof of licensing (including up to date immunization records) must be present upon registration. Pets are to be on an attended leash at all times and owners will be responsible for cleaning up after them.
6. Boys are not permitted in the girl's sleeping area & girls are not permitted in the boy's sleeping area.
7. All persons on the campgrounds are expected to attend the age appropriate scheduled services.
8. All person on the campgrounds are to retire to their respective quarters at the established time for each encampment, and to remain there until the signal for rising. No unnecessary lights & noise are permitted during sleeping hours. Curfew is from 11:00PM until 7:00AM.
9. Anyone between the ages of 12 & 17 years of age must register for the youth program at the Camp Office upon arrival at camp.
10. Youth under the age of 18, (who are not on the camp staff) planning to stay on the campgrounds during Family Camp but not accompanied by a parent, must have an adult sponsor, approved by the parent and the Camp Manager. The parent or adult sponsor will be fully responsible for the youth. In addition, all youth will be required to reside with their parent or sponsor during the curfew hours (11PM - 7AM)
11. A parent, adult sponsor or staff member designated must accompany anyone under the age of 18 wishing to leave the campgrounds. In the unique situation where none of the above can accompany the camper, permission must be obtained from the Camp Manager to leave the grounds.
12. Everyone is to be discreet at all times in the display of affection on the campgrounds.
13. Only Christian music shall be played on the campgrounds and that not with a volume, which would disturb other campers.
14. Due to insurance regulations and other considerations, no permission will be granted for swimming in unauthorized, unsupervised, or unguarded areas.
15. Any case of illness, injury or infection must be reported immediately to the Camp Nurse.
16. The person responsible to breaking or damaging camp property will be charged for the repair or full replacement cost. Necessary labor costs will also be added.
17. Distribution of literature, solicitations of funds, advertising or selling of merchandise for any cause are forbidden without written consent from the Camp Board.
18. No one is permitted to disseminate doctrines contrary to the Church of the Nazarene.
19. The Camp Discipline Review Committee chaired by the Camp Manager will handle any discipline problems.
